BECOME A LEADER IN YOUR ASSOCIATION JOIN A COMMITTEE

New SAMCAR Committees will be forming for 2012. Members are urged to take part in the planning of association activities, legislative issues, technology programs, member services and Professional Standards.

AFFILIATE Council Increases Affiliate visibility within SAMCAR and supports SAMCAR through education, events and membership.

EDUCATION Committee Recommends courses and presentations that are pertinent to the industry and current trends for our membership's knowledge and growth in professionalism and success. Also plans the Broker Manager Meetings.

ELECTIONS Committee Qualifies the candidates for each place to be filled on the Board of Directors to ascertain that they are eligible to hold elective office based on the qualifications stated in the By-Laws and in the Policy and Procedures Manual. Also selects annual award winners.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY Committee Creates a more sustainable San Mateo County, by providing resources and opportunities that will empower our membership to understand and appreciate the characteristics and values of the diverse segments within our community.

FINANCE Committee Reviews the monthly financial reports of the Association's operation, assists in preparation of annual budget. Monitors the financial health and investment direction of the Association.

GRIEVANCE Committee Conducts a preliminary review of disciplinary complaints to determine whether the complaint should be forwarded to a Hearing Panel of the Professional Standards Committee (*training required to serve on this committee*).

LEGISLATIVE Committee Local area Legislative Committees review issues and share information. Provides feedback to the Government Affairs Director on current legislative issues. Provides an audience for council members and staff. Holds forums for local elections. Committee members meet monthly at the local level and as necessary at the regional level.

MEMBER SERVICES Committee Plans New Member Orientation sessions. Suggests and plans strategies for retaining members and attracting new members.

PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS Committee Members of this committee act as panelists for disciplinary and arbitration hearings (*training is required to serve on this committee*).

PUBLIC RELATIONS / Local Marketing Meetings Committee Assists local marketing meeting committees with meeting program format, speaker selection, topic and other related arrangements. Members are also encouraged to assist staff in locating speakers for combined tour meetings.

SPECIAL EVENTS Committee Plans and promotes various association social and Foundation fund raising events including holiday celebrations, installation, etc., as requested and approved by the Board of Directors.

TECHNOLOGY Taskforce Assists and makes recommendations regarding Association's Web site, computer systems and use of technology.

YPN (Young Professionals Network) YPN covers several areas such as education, networking, mentoring, leadership development, community service, sharing ideas and information. YPN groups are nationwide and are supported by N.A.R. and C.A.R. and local associations. This group is geared primarily to REALTORS®, however we do encourage affiliate participation at events but have limited membership space available for affiliates.
